

Reservoir Substation major works

September 2023

Update 1

The Department of Transport and Planning and Yarra Trams are building a new substation at 816 Plenty Road, Reservoir. This will upgrade the tram power supply system to ensure sufficient power to meet future local transport needs and the increased demands on the tram network. As part of these works, we will be installing new underground services from the footpath to the new substation location.

 When	<p>9pm, Saturday 23 September to 6am, Monday 25 September (24-hour works).</p>
 Where	<p>Works will take place at the site of the existing substation and extend on to the footpath.</p>
 Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – One westbound lane on Plenty Road will be closed during works. – Traffic management and signage will direct traffic, please follow signage around works.
 Work	<p>24-hour works will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Setting up work area, including traffic management. – Isolating the existing substation. – Installing new underground services for the new substation.
 Noise/Dust	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Mostly low to medium levels of noise at night. – Some periods of high levels of noise during the day.
 Trams	<p>There will be service changes to tram Route 86 during the works. For more information visit: yarratrams.com.au/service-changes</p>
 Pedestrians	<p>There will be temporary footpath closures around the worksite with localised detours in place.</p>
 Businesses	<p>Businesses in Summerhill Shopping Centre will be open during the works and will be accessible via footpaths and the existing car park. Please continue to support local businesses during these essential tram works.</p>
