



Notice of works

July 2024

The Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) and Yarra Trams will soon be delivering 12 level-access tram stops at six locations along La Trobe Street, at Docklands Stadium (Stop D1), Spencer Street (Stop 1), William Street (Stop 3), Elizabeth Street (Stop 5), Swanston Street (Stop 6) and Exhibition Street (Stop 8) in July and August of this year. These will be delivered in two stages.

To facilitate part of the first stage of these upgrades, we will require a site compound for the amenity and first aid of workers, and site management at the southern end of Wills Street. See maps overleaf. Some parking will be temporarily unavailable as indicated from Wednesday 3 July to Saturday 27 July 2024.

This compound will be temporary and be removed when works have concluded. The compound will not be assessable to the public with fencing in place and there will be a small generator to provide power. Footpaths will remain open around the compounds and the work zones.

Early works compound - 7am, Wednesday 3 July to 7pm, Thursday 11 July 2024:

- To be located in three car parks on the west side of Wills Street.
- No impact to traffic.


Major works compound - 7pm, Thursday 11 July to 4am, Saturday 27 July 2024:

- To be located in three car parks on the west side of Wills Street.
- Extending further into Wills Street, eight car parks on the east side, for the storage of some material for the major works construction.
- The intersection of Wills and La Trobe streets will be closed during major works and access to Wills Street and Singers Lane will be maintained with traffic management via A'Beckett Street as indicated below.
